

Statement of Purpose

Introduction:

I am Aparajita Bhattacharjee, born in Bangladesh, and holder of Bangladeshi passport number A20649523. I am the daughter of Arabinda Bhattacharjee and Monika Biswas. I have completed my MBA from Madan Mohan College, Sylhet. I am married to a wonderful guy named Suchayan Chakraborty Shoumik, who is now pursuing his Master of Sustainable Infrastructure with Project Management at Queensland University of Technology (QUT) in Brisbane, Australia. We have a beautiful 2 years old daughter named Adyatroyee. With my husband and I living in two different countries, the distance is causing us both a lot of emotional pain, and the deprivation of fatherly affection is having a serious negative impact on our little child and my husband is facing difficulties to focus on his studies for this situation. In this Statement of Purpose, I am going to share my genuine intention to temporarily join my husband in Australia. My deepest desire is to be reunited with my partner of life and offer him the emotional and practical support he needs to succeed academically and to provide our child a fair chance to be with both of her parents.

Educational Background and Employment Status:

I have completed my SSC from Satgaon High School with a GPA 4.19 out of 5.00 and HSC from Sreemangal Govt College with a GPA 4.08 out of 5.00. Then I did my BBA (Management, CGPA 3.14 out of 4.00) from Moulvibazar Mahila College, Moulvibazar and MBA (Management, CGPA 2.91 out of 4.00) from Madan Mohan College, Sylhet. Currently, I'm a housewife, and a responsible mother of a child.

My strong relationship with my husband and our shared journey:

We got married on 07 February 2022. Since our marriage, my husband has showered me with ample respect and endless love. We both are very dependent on each other. A few months after our marriage, during my pregnancy in August 2023, my husband met with a road accident. During that illness, I was always by my husband's side and provided him with all kinds of emotional and material support. In this way, our mutual trust and confidence have become stronger. We are each other's biggest helpers in times of danger. On 1 January 2024, a beautiful baby girl was born to light up our home. After the birth of my baby, I was going through a very difficult time. Since I had no previous experience in raising a child, I didn't know what to do. But my husband, who was my savior, helped me a lot, from holding the baby in my arms to taking care of the

baby. He took very good care of the baby and me. A few months after the birth of our child, my husband got an opportunity to pursue higher education in Australia and he migrated to Australia in July 2025 for his studies. He will complete his studies there next year. However, after my husband moved abroad, my daughter and I miss him very much, and it is very important for our daughter to have her father close at this age.

The Profound Impact of Long Distance:

No matter how much we talk on the phone or stay virtually connected, the pain of not being able to be present in person or holding hands when we are upset is very painful for a husband and wife. My husband suffers from loneliness abroad and is constantly worried about his wife and young child, so that he is not able to focus properly on his studies. Meanwhile, I also worry all the time about how the man is managing everything alone in a foreign land, what he is eating or what he is wearing. As a wife, I am not able to be by his side, and this also hurts me a lot. On the other hand, our daughter has been deprived of her father's affection and love since a few months after her birth. A child's mental development is at its peak until the age of 5, but at this age, the absence of our daughter's father is severely hampering that development, which will negatively affect her future sweet relationship with her father and her own mental stability.

The purpose of the temporary reunion:

Sometimes emotions and bonds are beyond explanation, sometimes we just crave the closest comfort, love, reassurance and of course peace. I know that it has become very difficult for my husband to feel emotionally stable and focus on his studies after leaving his wife and child behind. In this situation, my presence and that of our child will comfort him and he will be able to successfully complete the last year of his master's program with focus, which will help him return home with us and build a successful career and a happy family here in Bangladesh. On the other hand, as our daughter grows up, she will no longer feel the pain of her father's absence and will have a healthy and sweet childhood surrounded by the love of her father and mother.

Commitment to return to Bangladesh:

I am here to ensure that I have a strong and genuine commitment to return to Bangladesh upon completion of my temporary visit to Australia in order to support my husband throughout his academic journey and provide our daughter a normal childhood filled with the presence and love from both of her parents. I am the only child of my parents. My father passed away when I was only 8 months old and then my mother

raised me alone. Now at this age, there is no one else to be by her side except me. I have a lot of responsibilities towards my mother, and to take care of her, as well as to take care of our family property as I am an only child, I have no choice but to return to Bangladesh. On the other hand, my husband is also the only son of his parents, so it is very important for him to return to Bangladesh and start a beautiful family with his parents and us. These familial and future settlement commitments firmly anchor me to Bangladesh and ensure our full compliance with all visa conditions, including departing Australia before my Visa expires.

Financial Support:

We are fully aware of the financial responsibilities associated with this visa application. My mother, Monika Biswas will be covering all expenses related to my short visit to Australia. My mother worked as a government employee till 2022. After retirement, she received a large pension. And there is some agricultural land in my mother's name in our village. We will ensure that all costs related to my travel, accommodation, and every other sector are covered, and being with my husband there for a very short time will not impose any financial burden on the Australian government or social welfare system.

Visa Condition of Australia:

I fully understand and respect the visa conditions of Australia and am committed to complying with all requirements of a Visit visa. My purpose of travel is strictly temporary and limited to visiting my husband for a short period to provide emotional support to him and provide a healthy childhood to our daughter. I have no intention to work, study, or overstay in Australia, and I will abide by all laws and conditions imposed by the Department of Home Affairs. As a Bangladeshi conscious citizen and a responsible child to a wonderful mother, I have strong personal ties to my home country that require my return after my visit. I am firmly determined to depart Australia before my visa expires and come back to Bangladesh with my husband and daughter to build our own paradise here with our loved ones in our home country.

Conclusion:

Finally, I humbly request that my visitor visa application be approved, as my purpose is entirely temporary and based on genuine personal circumstances. This visit will provide me with the opportunity to support my husband during a difficult emotional time and to assist in meeting the needs of my daughter's childhood while fully complying with all the conditions of the Australian visa.
